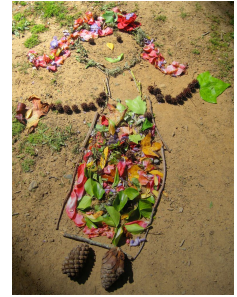

Do you like to recycle? Using found objects from around the house, make a robot sculpture! Give it a name!



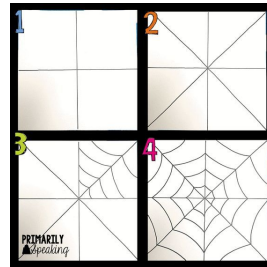
Collect nature objects from around your yard and create something amazing! Leaves, sticks, acorns, moss, and rocks can be your art supplies!



If you had your own castle, what would it look like? Draw your own castle, inside and outside, and make sure to have secret passages and a treasure room!



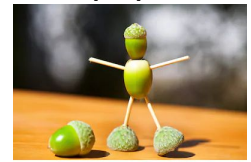
